- **Industries that provide sense of identity** 62% of adults working in the health care industry and 70% of those working in education say they get a sense of identity from their job, compares with 42% of people working in hospitality and 36% in retail or wholesale trade. (Pew Social Trends)
- **Job or Career:** Those with at least a bachelor's degree are about twice as likely as those with less education to say their job is a career (41%, compared with 21% of those with some college experience and 22% of those with a high school diploma or less). These groups with lower education are more likely to say their job is just to get them by. (Pew Social Trends)
